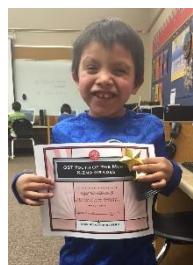
Easter Egg Hunt 2016

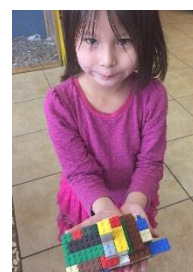
