Lights On Afterschool Event, October 22, 2015 Enemy Swim Day School

On October 22nd, Enemy Swim Day School OST Program will host a celebration as part of *Lights On Afterschool*, a nationwide rally for afterschool programs that is expected to include some 7,500 events this year. In all, one million Americans are expected to join in events across the country to draw attention to the need for more afterschool programs. At the event, parents and supporters will sign a new petition that urges lawmakers not to deny or divert funding for afterschool programs.

ESDS OST's *Lights On Afterschool* event will be held at Enemy Swim Day School from 5:30 to 7:30 pm. The event will include a book fair, health & wellness booths, arts & crafts, a meal, a basketball game, and many other activities! ESDS OST currently serves 200 students from Enemy Swim Day School providing them a safe place to go after the school day ends.
