For 3rd – 5th Grade (Should also know words from K-2nd grade)

akaηuηpi (coat) hduwin (get ready) huηska (leggings-socks) napiηkpa (gloves-mittens) sapa (dirty)

For 6th – 8th Grade (Should also know words from K-2nd and 3rd – 5th)

Mahed uηzoġe (underclothing) tahuocosye (scarf) yuśpu (unbutton or unhook) bduśdoke (undress yourself)
