For Kindergarten – 2nd Grade

Heced (that way), oĥdate (under), icaħda (beside), akaŋ (on), mahed (in), imahed (inside), timahed (inside a building), itaŋkad (outside), takad (out), koka (box), maza koka (can), jaŋjaŋ (jar), wojuha (sack or bag)

For 3rd – 5th Grade (Should also know words from K-2nd grade)

lyohakab (after), itokab (in front), iĥeyata (back-behind), kaħda (beside), hetkiya (towards), etapa (right), catka (left), iwaŋkab (above), ihukud, kud, opta

For 6th – 8th Grade (Should also know words from K-2nd and 3rd – 5th)

sni kiŋħaŋ (unless), heħaŋyaŋ (until), uŋmaŋtunkte (whether), toħaŋyaŋ (as long as), isakib (beside), tokatakiya (forward), ikiyena (near), ohomni, heyake opiyena (suitcase), mazaska wojuha (purse), caŋopiye wohnaka (dresser)
