iha (perhaps), kepce (I think so), kinica (almost) , kiŋhaŋ (if), okini (perhaps), oɣo (all over something), se'ce (seems like)

For 6th – 8th Grade (Should also know words from K-2nd and 3rd – 5th)

henuh (perhaps), iyenakca (enough), iyuseya (barely), na, ob (with a group), t'ka (but), nakuŋ (also)
