POSITION DESCRIPTION

<u>Title:</u> Afterschool Group Leader, Summer Activity Leader or Summer Assistant Activity Leader

POSITION RESPONSIBILITES:

- 1. Write/Plan/Prepare/Lead daily school-age student activities (inside and outside) (K-8th),
- 2. Responsible for direct Supervision and Safety of school-age students (1 adult per 10 to 15 students),
- 3. Maintain daily accountability of students,
- 4. Document all daily student incidents/consequences and/or treatment given (including discipline, illness, and first aid),
- 5. Maintain and enforce the OST Discipline/Reprimand Policy,
- 6. Maintain and enforce OST Expectations of all areas used during the program,
- 7. Responsible for clean-up of all Afterschool activities,
- 8. Attend mandatory CPR and First Aid certification-training,
- 9. Attend required trainings-18 hours per year (CPR/FA not included in the 18 hours) and professional development classes (to include but not limited to; health and safety practices, discipline, scheduling, education, future planning, child development, child academic achievement and problem solving),
- 10. Attend ESDS staff meetings, when requested by the School Community Director, Principal or Superintendent to collaborate with teachers and other staff,
- 11. Attend Special Events as scheduled (Set-Up, Lead Activities, Clean-Up),
- 12. Disinfect equipment,
- 13. Prepare snacks,
- 14. Assist with licensing and accreditation process,
- 15. And perform other duties as assigned.
- 16. During a pandemic, all employees will be designated as essential staff. Employees may be assigned to duties that would be categorized under other job duties such as bus driver (suburban/mini bus), bus monitor (monitor students and/or deliver meals), kitchen assistant (help prepare meals), family outreach and/or other duties to keep the continuity of the school running smoothly.

POSITION QUALIFICATIONS:

Preferred High School Diploma/GED or, actively working on GED and must be 18 years of age or older, Energetic, Physically Active (due to fast paced working environment), Enjoys working with school-age children. Must pass background check.

HOURS/SCHEDULE:

Dates as Scheduled during the ESDS School Year and/or Summer Afterschool, typically 5 hours from 12:30pm 5:30pm M-Th and Special Events/Field Trips during the evening or on week-ends scheduled throughout the school year. Summer, typically 8am to 3pm M-Th with possible evening event. (See Staff calendar for scheduled dates)
